

TITANIC SINKS; 1,500 ARE DROWNED

The Most Appalling Disaster in the History of Ocean Travel

World's Greatest Steamer, on Maiden Voyage, Plunges Beneath the Surface With Its Human Freight, After Terrible Collision With North Atlantic Iceberg—Call for Help Answered by Steamer Carpathia, but Other Vessels Come Too Late.

MEN DIE HEROES TO SAVE WOMEN

Permit All Women and Children to Occupy the Lifeboats Where They Were Picked Up—Pecuniary Loss Runs Away in the Millions—Boats Still Search Wreckage for Dead and Living—Ship Sunk in Two Miles of Water.

FACTS ABOUT THE TITANIC, THE WORLD'S BIGGEST SHIP

Length 883½ feet. Displacement, 66,000 tons. Tons register, 46,000. Beam, 92½ feet. Depth, 94 feet. Had on board 2,200 souls. Crew, 860. The cost of the great ship was ten millions, and she was fitted up like a palace, with tennis courts, palm gardens, Turkish and electric baths, ball room, winter gardens and "regal" suites. She was on her first voyage.

BOSTON, April 15.—A wireless message picked up late to night, relayed from the Olympic, says that the Carpathia is on her way to New York with 566 passengers from the steamer Titanic. They are mostly women and children, the message says, and it continued:

"Grave fears are felt for the safety of the balance of the passengers and crew."

Dead May Total Close to 1,800.

NEW YORK, April 15.—The text of the message from the steamer Olympic, reporting the sinking of the Titanic and the rescue of 675 survivors, which reached here late to night, also expressed the opinion that 1,800 lives were lost.

"Less likely total 1,800 souls," the dispatch said in its concluding sentence.

It is hoped and believed here that this is an error, unless the Titanic had more passengers on board than was reported. The list, as given out, showed 1,310 passengers and a crew of 860, or 2,170 persons in all. Deducting 675, the known saved, would indicate a loss of 1,495 persons.

The Olympic's dispatch follows:

Carpathia reached Titanic position at daybreak. Found boats and wreckage only. Titanic sank about 5:20 a. m. in 41:16 N., 50:14 W. All her boats accounted for containing about 675 souls saved, crew and passengers included. Nearly all saved women and children. Leyland liner California remained and is searching exact position of disaster. Loss likely total 1,500 souls."

Titanic Sank in Two Miles of Water.

HALIFAX, April 15.—The deathbed of the \$10,000,000 steamer Titanic, and of probably many who must have been dragged with her, is two miles at least below the surface of the sea.

The calculation was made by an official of the government marine department, who finds that depth on the marine chart at a point about 500 miles from Halifax, and about 70 miles south of the Grand Banks, where he believes the Titanic went down.

Virginian Has Some of Passengers.

NEW YORK, April 15.—A dispatch from St. Johns, N. F., received at 2:15 o'clock this morning, gives rise to the hope that the steamer Virginian has some of the Titanic's survivors on board. The message said she would bring to St. Johns such survivors as she "may rescue." Hope arises from the fact that the steamer is putting in there at all, which she would scarcely do were there not some humane necessity for this action. She was outward-bound for Liverpool.

While the fate of the majority of the 2,100 persons on board the mammoth White Star liner Titanic, which sank early yesterday on the New Foundland Banks, after a collision with an iceberg, still remains in doubt and it is feared more than 1,200 persons were lost, a note of good cheer came from the ocean ways by wireless between one and two o'clock this morning.

Olympic Heard From.

It was in the shape of a wireless message from the White Star line Olympic, one of the vessels hovering near the scene of the disaster, flashing the news that 666 of the Titanic's passengers, mostly women and children, were being brought to port by the Cunarder Carpathia. Other messages later brought confirmatory tidings.

First reports were that the Carpathia had saved but 675 persons. The new figures reduced the list of those for whose fate fear was felt by nearly 200, and if, as seems probable, practically all those saved were passengers, it would appear that all but approximately 400 of the vessel's passengers are accounted for. A partial list of the survivors received from the Carpathia includes the names of many women of prominence who were on the steamer.

BIG ICEBERGS FILL SEA

REPORTS PASSENGER FROM THE CARMANIA

Biggest "Growlers" Almost Awash With Sea Dangerous to All Steamers.

NEW YORK, April 15.—J. H. Wells, a Liverpool ship owner, who reached New York yesterday on the liner Carmania, gave an interesting account today of the ice fields the ship encountered off the Grand Banks, on Thursday. "I have crossed the ocean nearly a hundred times," he said, "but never before have I seen ice so far south and in such a great body."

MORGANTOWN PEOPLE WERE ON TITANIC

FEARS FOR SAFETY ARE ENTERTAINED

Daughter of Congressman Hughes and Husband Returning From Honeymoon.

The Intelligencer, last night, made efforts to ascertain if any Wheeling or West Virginia people were among the passengers of the Titanic. Inquiry of the New York agents declared there were no Wheeling people on the steamer, and that so far as known, only two from West Virginia—Mr. and Mrs. Lucian Smith, of Morgantown, the latter a daughter of Congressman James Hughes. They were returning from their honeymoon in Egypt to Morgantown, where they intended to make their future home. Their wedding occurred at Huntington but a few weeks ago, almost immediately after the debut of the bride in Washington society.

The Intelligencer received the following special from Huntington last night:

HUNTINGTON, W. Va., April 15.—Mr. and Mrs. Lucian P. Smith returning from a honeymoon trip from Egypt are among the passengers on the ill-fated steamer Titanic. Nothing had been heard from them at a late hour tonight. Mrs. Smith is the daughter of Congressman James A. Hughes, and was married a few months ago to Mr. Lucian Smith, a prominent young man of Morgantown, W. Va.

Vanderbilt Didn't Sail.

NEW YORK, April 15.—Mrs. Cornelius Vanderbilt received a cablegram late today from Alfred G. Vanderbilt, her son, saying that he had not sailed on the Titanic and was safe in London.

This announcement was made at the Vanderbilt home tonight.

YOUNGSTOWN PEOPLE ON THE TITANIC.

YOUNGSTOWN, Ohio, April 15.—Among the passengers on board the ill-fated Titanic, which went down this morning were: Colonel George D. Wick, Mrs. George D. Wick, Miss Natalie Wick and Miss Caroline Bonnell, of this city. No word has been heard from them and it is thought they were lost.

GIVE UP HOPE

OF SAVING ANY SAVE 675 ON THE CARPATHIA.

Believed Other Boats Reached Scene Too Late; Owners Stunned By Horror.

NEW YORK, April 15.—Vice-President Franklin D. Roosevelt, who had been in the Titanic disaster, said that he had no information to disprove the Associated Press from Cape Race to the effect that only 675 of the passengers and crew had been rescued. He said that the monetary loss could not be estimated to night, although he intimated that it would run into the millions. "We can replace the money," he added, "but not the lives. It is horrible."

Mr. Franklin continued: "As far as we know, it has been rumored from Halifax that three steamers have passengers on board, namely, the Virginian, the Carpathia and the Parisian. Now, we have heard from Captain Haddock, that the Titanic sank at 2:30 this morning. We have also learned from him that the Carpathia had 675 survivors on board. It is very difficult to learn if the Virginian and the Parisian have any survivors on board. We have asked Captain Haddock and our agent at Halifax to ascertain if there are any passengers aboard the two steamers."

Mr. Franklin said there was a sufficient number of life boats to take all the passengers from the Titanic. He said that he had been confident to night, when he made the statement, that "the Titanic was unsinkable," that the steamer was safe and that there would be no loss of life. The first definite news received came in the message from Captain Haddock, that the Titanic sank at 2:30 this morning. "We have no information that there are any passengers aboard those two steamers."

Owners Are Stunned.

MONEY KINGS ON TITANIC

JOHN JACOB ASTOR RICHEST OF THEM ALL.

Others Were Benjamin Guggenheim, Smelter, and George D. Widner, Traction King.

Also Isidor Straus, Merchant, W. T. Stead, Writer, and Thomas Pears, of Pittsburgh.

NEW YORK, April 15.—Untold wealth was represented among the passengers of the Titanic, there being on board at least six millionaires, of whose fortunes might be reckoned in tens of millions of dollars. A total estimate of wealth represented in the first class passengers would reach over a half a billion dollars.

The wealthiest of the list is Colonel John Jacob Astor, head of the famous house, whose name he bears, who is reported to be worth \$150,000,000. Mr. Astor was returning from a tour of Egypt with his bride, who was Miss Madeleine Force, to whom he was married in Providence on September 9.

Benjamin Guggenheim, probably next in financial importance, is the fifth of the seven sons of Meyer Guggenheim, who founded the American Smelting & Refining Company, the great mining corporation, and is director of many corporations, including the International Steam Pump Company, of which he is also president. His fortune is estimated at \$50,000,000. His wife, whose name does not appear on the passenger list, is the daughter of James Seligman, the New York banker.

Isidor Straus, one of New York's most prominent drygoods merchants and notable for his philanthropies, has a fortune also estimated to be worth \$50,000,000. He is a director
