ed. There must have been at least 30 explosions in the furnace room as the icy waters reached the fires The Admiralty here computes the Titanic's position at the bottom to be eight miles from the spot when the liner sank. It says that it prob-ably took the vessel 13 minutes to reach the bottom, two miles below the surface.




