this afternoon: "We are in communication with the steamship Carpathia and in position to officially announce that the White Star liner, Titanic, struck an enormous iceberg and sank, over two thousand people being lost. Seven hundred survivors, mostly women, are on the Carpa-thia."

When questioned as to the accuracy of these figures the Camper-down station replied that the Carpathia knows nothing authentic about the number of lives lost when the Titanic sank, but said that taking into account the pas-sengers that boarded the liner at Cherbourg will probably bring the death list up considerably higher than heretofore estimated. The Camperdown wireless station also said that there are seven hundred and ten survivors of the Titanic aboard the Carpathia evidently meaning passengers, other survivors on that vessel being members of the Titanic's crew who were requir ed to man the life boats.
